# Tele Work Participation at OPIC

- 30% of employees participate in tele work and/or alternative work arrangements.
- Expected to rise significantly based on recent enhancements to tele work and alternative work arrangement policies.

# Secure Remote Access Considerations



- Requirement - End User PC Access  
*(Non-Gov't Furnished Equipment)*
  - Protect the OPIC Network
  - Protect Sensitive Information
  - Comply with Federal Requirements



# Secure Remote Access

- Citrix MetaFrame Presentation Server
  - *Secure Virtual Desktop*
- RSA Tokens (two-factor authentication)
  - Can be used from any PC with internet access
    - End Point Security
    - Network Security

# Secure Remote Access (cont.)



- Other mobile devices :
  - Loaner Laptops / Netbooks
  - Smart Phones (BlackBerry's)
  - Thumb Drives

# Key Policy Considerations & Procedures



- Tele work Program /Handbook
- Participants are required to sign Tele work Agreement
- Same policies that apply to OPIC workspace also apply to remote work spaces
- One-on-One Instruction with End Users
